

AMENITIES

Multipurpose Room—The 2,500 square foot room will be used for a variety of programs such as luncheons, art classes, enrichment classes, fitness classes, and special events. The room can be divided into three separate rooms to host multiple programs at the same time. The multipurpose room will be available to rent for banquets, receptions, meetings, luncheons, and much more.

Kitchen—The kitchen will feature a full size stove, refrigerator, microwave and dishwasher. This facility will be used as a warming kitchen. It will be available to rent along with the multipurpose room for a variety of events.

Gymnasium—The full size gym will be utilized for a majority of recreational activities including volleyball, gymnastics, basketball, tennis, self defense, and much more. The gym will be available for rent to outside organizations upon availability.

Fitness Area and Indoor walking track—The fitness area and walking track will be located on the second floor of the community center. The walking track will have three lanes and 18 laps will equal a mile. The community center will also feature top of the line fitness equipment including treadmills, recumbent bikes, upright bikes, total body machines and multiple weight machines that will work your entire body. The fitness area and track will be open Monday-Saturday. Participants will be required to purchase a daily, monthly or yearly pass to use the fitness area, walking track and open gym.

Family Track Hours— The track will have designated “Family Hours” when the children 12 and under may be on the track with an adult. At all other times it is restricted to those 13 years and older. Children 12 and under will not be allowed to use cardio equipment nor weight equipment. Children 12 and under must be supervised at all times by a member parent.

Family - Those persons living together as parent - guardians and dependants claimed on their taxes.

12 years old and under - Children 12 and under must be supervised at all times with a member, parents or guardian.

1. Photo ID: Driver's License, state ID or school ID.
2. Proof of Residence: Current utility bill: gas, cable, electric, landline telephone, car registration, water or sewer. Envelopes with addresses displayed will not be accepted.
