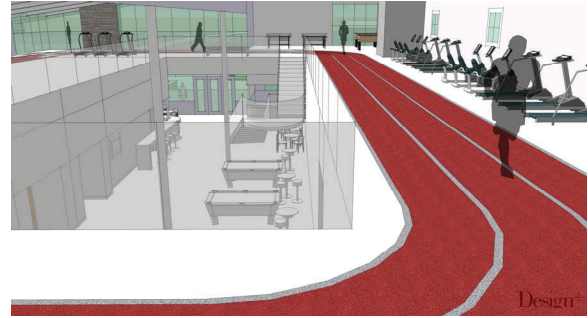




Byron Township Community Center



The Byron Township Community Center will be a facility for all ages to enjoy. The new building will be located in Whistlestop Park, 2120—76th Street. The Parks and Recreation Department will be located in the new facility. Programs for all ages will take place at the community center Monday-Saturday year around.

The Byron Township Community Center is looking at a Grand Opening in early 2009.

Community Center Amenities

Multipurpose Room—The 2,500 square foot room will be used for a variety of programs such as luncheons, art classes, enrichment classes, fitness classes, and special events. The room can be divided into three separate rooms to host multiple programs at the same time. The multipurpose room will be available to rent for banquets, receptions, meetings, luncheons, and much more.

Kitchen—The kitchen will feature a full size stove, refrigerator, microwave and dishwasher. This facility will be used as a warming kitchen. It will be available to rent along with the multipurpose room for a variety of events.

Gymnasium—The full size gym will be utilized for a majority of recreational activities including volleyball, gymnastics, basketball, tennis, self defense, and much more. The gym will be available for rent to outside organizations upon availability.

Fitness Area and Indoor walking track—The fitness area and walking track will be located on the second floor of the community center. The walking track will have three lanes and 18 laps will equal a mile. The community center will also feature top of the line fitness equipment including treadmills, recumbent bikes, upright bikes, total body machines and multiple weight machines that will work your entire body. The fitness area and track will be open Monday-Saturday. Participants will be required to purchase a daily, monthly or yearly pass to use the fitness area, walking track and open gym.

Lounge Areas—There will be two lounge areas for people to use if they are waiting for other participants or to just go and relax and read a book. Bring your laptop along to access the facility's wi-fi to catch up on some work or check your email.
