

**Byron Township Board Meeting**

A regular meeting of the Byron Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Audrey Nevins on Monday, October 10, 2005 at 7:00 p.m., at the Byron Township Offices, 8085 Byron Center Avenue, Byron Center Michigan.
