A regular meeting of the Byron Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Audrey Nevins on Monday, January 9, 2006 at 7:00 p.m., at the Byron Township Offices, 8085 Byron Center Avenue, Byron Center Michigan.

A motion was made by Paul Nevins and supported by Burgess, that the Board approve the minutes of the regular meeting held December 27, 2005 as amended.
