A regular meeting of the Byron Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Audrey Nevins on Monday, May 22, 2006 at 7:00 p.m., at the Byron Township Offices, 8085 Byron Center Avenue, Byron Center Michigan.

A motion was made by Slot and supported by Burgess, that the Board approve the minutes of the regular meeting held May 8, 2006 as presented.

A motion was made by Slot and supported by Wustman, that the Board approve the accounts payable for the following funds in the amounts stated: General Fund \$44,408.30; Fire Operation and Maintenance Fund \$2,276.69; Water Fund \$186,281.36; Sewer Fund \$173,094.10.
