A special meeting of the Byron Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Audrey Nevins on Wednesday, October 4, 2006, at 9:15 a p.m., at the Gaines Byron Township Hall, 8085 Byron Center Avenue, Byron Center, Michigan.

Rod Korhorn from Prein and Newhof made a presentation to the Board on options available for sewer extension to the northwest section of the Township.

Option 1: Build sewer along the Knight Drain and where the Jamestown and Byron Sewers converge, pipe it to Grandville Treatment Facility.

Option 2: Build sewer along the Knight Drain and where the Jamestown and Byron Sewers converge, pump it up to Wyoming lines to Wyoming Treatment Plant

Option 3: Build sewer along the Knight Drain and where the Jamestown and Byron Sewers converge, build our own membrane filtration station, clean the sewer and discharge to Rush Creek.

The Board discussed feasibilities of the plan and how these options affect the east side of Wilson Avenue PA 425 agreement discussions.

Rod Korhorn and Julie Meza will put together some potential costs of the trunk sewer that would run through the possible 425 area.

A motion was made by Houseman and supported by Slot that the meeting adjourns. Yes – 5 No – 0 Absent – 2 The motion carried.
