

**Byron Township Board Meeting**  
**January 22, 2007**  
**Minutes**

A regular meeting of the Byron Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Audrey Nevins on Monday, January 22, 2007, at 7:00 p.m., at the Byron Township Offices, 8085 Byron Center Avenue, Byron Center Michigan.

Prayer was offered by Paul Nevins.

Recognition of Guests, Visitors, and Township Residents.

Russ Jansen, Cutlerville Fire Chief, was introduced to the Board. Mr. Jansen had two requests from the Board. The first was for a used 2002 mini pumper in the amount of \$87,500 and a multifunction printer in the amount of \$699.

A motion was made by Hondorp and supported by Wustman, that the Board approve the purchase of the mini pumper in the amount of \$87,500.

A motion was made by Slot and supported by Hondorp, that the Board approve the purchase of a multifunction printer in the amount of \$699.

A motion was made by Slot and supported by Houseman, that the Board approve the minutes of the regular meeting held January 8, 2007 and the special meetings held January 17 and 18, 2007, as presented.

A motion was made by Hondorp and supported by Houseman, that the Board approve the accounts payable for the following funds in the amounts stated: General Fund \$64,431.93; Fire Operation and Maintenance Fund \$15,244.84; Water Fund \$304,723.76; Sewer Fund \$9,624.73; Law Fund \$43,364.77.

The Board held a discussion with developers and engineers representing residents on Wilson Avenue north of M-6 about utility extensions.

Supervisor Audrey Nevins opened the Public Hearing for the DDA expansion at 7:30 p.m.

Cozette Tournell, 1918 Portadown, had concerns about commercial coming too close to residential.

The Public Hearing was closed at 7:35 p.m.

The Board discussed NPDES Phase II.

A motion was made by Paul Nevins and supported by Houseman, that the Board accept the low bid from Municipal Code Corporation to codify the General Ordinances for an amount not to exceed \$11,000.
