

**Byron Township Board Meeting**  
**February 12, 2007**  
**Minutes**

A regular meeting of the Byron Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Audrey Nevins on Monday, February 12, 2007, at 7:00 p.m., at the Byron Township Offices, 8085 Byron Center Avenue, Byron Center Michigan.

Recognition of Guests, Visitors, and Township Residents.

A motion was made by Paul Nevins and supported by Burgess, that the Board approve the minutes of the regular meeting held January 22, 2007 and the special meeting held February 8, 2007, as presented.

A motion was made by Hondorp and supported by Houseman, that the Board approve the accounts payable for the following funds in the amounts stated: General Fund \$17937.55; Fire Operation and Maintenance Fund \$17143.74; Water Fund \$59,395.83; Sewer Fund \$30,426.94; Law Fund \$28,076.50.

Supervisor Audrey Nevins opened the Public Hearing for the Corridor Improvement Authority District at 7:02 p.m.

Residents and Business owners in the proposed district had several questions about the CIA. Supervisor Nevins, Clerk, Hondorp, and Treasurer Houseman gave a detailed explanation on the makeup, operation and tax increment financing plan in a Corridor Improvement District.

The Public Hearing was closed at 7:20 p.m.
